



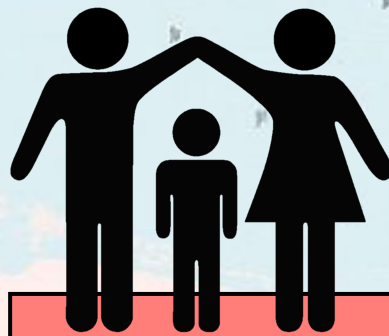

Change the privacy settings.

Report the incident to the service provider to remove any hurtful content.

Block the sender.

Tell a trusted adult who can help or call a helpline.
