### **UPDATES ON SCHOOL MATTERS IN VIEW OF FULL HOME-BASED LEARNING (HBL)**

Starting from Wednesday 19 May 2021, all primary, secondary, junior college and Millennia Institute students will shift to full Home-Based Learning (HBL) till end of the term on 28 May 2021. As such, please take note of the changes that the school has made with regard to the following school matters.

#### **1) Engagement Sessions with P5 and P6 Parents – PSLE 2021 Supporting Students and Parents in Making School Choices**

The Engagement Sessions with P5 and P6 parents on 'PSLE 2021 Supporting Students and Parents in Making School Choices', scheduled to take place on Friday, 21 May 2021 will be postponed to **Monday, 31 May 2021**. Both sessions will be carried via Zoom in view of the enhanced safe management measures of Phase 2 (Heightened Alert) from 16 May 2021.

The revised schedule is as follows: -

P6 session	8.30 a.m. to 10.00 a.m.
P5 session	10.30 a.m. to 12.00 p.m.

#### **2) P5 Foundation Mother Tongue (FMT) and P6 Higher Mother Tongue (HMT) Mid-Year Assessments**

The P5 FMT and P6 HMT mid-year assessments originally scheduled for Wednesday, 19 May 2021 will be postponed to **Tuesday, 29 June 2021**.

#### **3) A Day at the Cove: Meet-the-Parents Session**

A Day at the Cove: Meet-the-Parents Session will be postponed to take place on **Friday, 9 July 2021**. A revised notification and booking form will be sent out to parents via Parents Gateway nearer the date.


Please also take note that the report books will be returned to all students on **Thursday, 8 July 2021**.
