Please take note of the following:

Absence from Assessment

- 1.1 Students who are unwell should not be in school. A medical certificate must cover any absence due to illness. Please submit the medical certificate(s) to the respective Form Teachers upon return to school.
- 1.2 Students with valid medical / compassionate reasons will be awarded VR ("Valid Reason") for the subject if they are absent for any of the examination components. Marks will then be pro-rated for the whole year accordingly.
- 1.3 Examples of non-valid reasons include:
 - Truancy
 - · Family-related reasons other than compassionate grounds
 - External examinations such as piano and ballet examinations.
- 1.4 Students will not be awarded any marks should they be absent **without** a medical certificate and a valid reason (subject to school's approval).
- 1.5 There is no make-up for all written papers. Should a student be absent for oral examinations, he/she may be allowed to sit for the 'Make-Up Oral Examination' with proof of a medical certificate or other valid reasons.
- 1.6 Students who are absent for written papers may sit for the papers as practice when they are back in school. However, their marks will be not recorded.

During Examination

- 2.1 Students are to be punctual for all examinations. Students who are late for more than 30 minutes are not allowed to take the exam. Students who are late within 30 minutes can still take the exam with no additional time given.
- 2.2 Students taking P5 & P6 Mathematics Paper 2 can only use approved calculator models for the examinations.
- 2.3 Students taking P4 to P6 Mother Tongue/Higher Mother Tongue Paper 1 (Composition) can only use approved dictionaries for examination. Attached is the link to the latest list of approved dictionaries for your information.
