Holistic Assessment focuses on developing the whole child and seeks to build confidence and a desire to learn in children.

To assess the different learning outcomes, the school has developed a range of age-appropriate assessments to enable our students to demonstrate their acquired skills.

At Primary 3, other than various formative assessments where students receive feedback for improvement, they also sit for Semestral Assessment Papers for various academic subjects in Term 4.

Please take note of the following:

**Absence from Assessment**

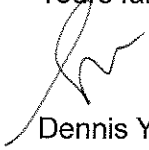
- 1.1 Students who are sick should not be in school for assessments. Any absence must be covered by a medical certificate. They will need to submit their medical certificate(s) to their form teacher when they return to school.
- 1.2 Students with valid medical / compassionate reasons will be awarded VR ("Valid Reason") for the subject if they are absent for any of the examination components. Marks will then be pro-rated for the whole year accordingly.
- 1.3 Examples of non-valid reasons include:
  - Truancy
  - Family-related reasons (except for compassionate grounds)
  - External examinations such as piano and ballet examinations
- 1.4 Students will not be awarded any marks should they be absent **without** a medical certificate and a valid reason (subject to school's approval).

1.5 There is no make-up for assessment papers except for the oral examination if students are absent. The make-up oral examination date will be scheduled. However, students must produce a medical certificate or have a valid reason in order to sit for the make-up oral examination.

1.6 Students who are absent for written papers may sit for the papers as practice when they are back in school. However, the marks will be not recorded.

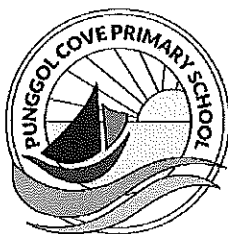
