**APRIL 2019****1) INTERNATIONAL FRIENDSHIP WEEK (15 – 18 April 2019)**

The school will be commemorating International Friendship Week from Monday, 15 April 2019 to Thursday, 18 April 2019 during curriculum time. More details of the activities will be given to the students nearer the week.

**2) GOOD FRIDAY**

Friday, 19 April 2019, is a public holiday. There is no school on this day.

**3) PRIMARY 2 PROGRAMME FOR ACTIVE LEARNING (PAL) OUTDOOR EDUCATION LEARNING JOURNEY**

All Primary 2 students will be going on a learning journey to Lorong Halus Wetland where they will participate in the Waterways Watch Explorer (WWE) programme.
