To facilitate your planning, here is an update of our activities for Term Two 2016.

MARCH 2016

- 1) **CLOSURE OF STUDENT CARE CENTRE (24 March 2016)**
The Student Care Centre will be closed on Thursday, 24 March 2016. As pupils will be dismissed at 1.30pm, please make arrangements for your child/ward to be picked up at that time.
- 2) **GOOD FRIDAY**
25 March is a public holiday.

APRIL 2016

- 3) **INTERNATIONAL FRIENDSHIP DAY**
The school will be commemorating International Friendship Day on Monday, 11 April 2016 during the curriculum time. On this day pupils will learn more about the countries in the ASEAN region. More details of the activities will be given to pupils nearer the date.
- 4) **WALKATON @ WATERWAY**
The walkathon will be held on 14 April 2016 in conjunction with the FairPrice Walk for Rice @ South East. Pupils will be walking a distance of 1.6km along the Punggol Waterway Park. For every 200m walked, 1 bowl of white rice and 1 bowl of brown rice, will be donated to under-privileged families in South East district. Through this platform, we seek to develop our pupils as a socially responsible citizens and contribute to the community.

Term Two June school holiday will begin from 28 May to 26 June 2016.


Photography and Videography
